Nury wins the CD6 runoff



With all precincts reporting, Martinez had 55 percent of the vote, or 4,917 votes compared to Montanez's 45 percent, or 4,093 votes. "This week felt so good in the field. Every door I knocked on, people were with me. I felt like I had the people power," Martinez said. "Our message got out there." Martinez becomes the only woman on the 15-member council. The council seat encompasses Lake Balboa, Sun Valley and Panorama City.



The DWP has offered to replace your lawn with drought tolerant foliage/landscaping. The water conservation effort has been in place since 2009, and the utility recently raised the rebate amount from \$1.50 to \$2 per square foot to generate more interest. Under the plan, homeowners can install up to 2,000 square feet of environmentally friendly landscape. Participants need to pre-apply for a rebate and receive DWP approval before starting the turf replacement. The agency will also inspect lawns before the removal starts and after landscaping is completed.

The process can be initiated by going to ladwp.com/CF. Participants are required to submit a photo of their lawn and a description of the planned project.

Taking advantage of the rebate program doesn't always mean committing to a cactus-covered yard. Homeowners can choose from a wide variety of trees, perennials, vines, succulents and shrubs. There are also innovative and appealing ways to enhance a yard with non-vegetative ground cover or such paving materials as decomposed granite, pea gravel, rocks, pebbles, mulch and wood chips, the DWP said. A list of landscaping options is available at bewaterwise.org. DWP officials believe the program can be a valuable conservation tool, as 40 percent of water use occurs outdoors.
